



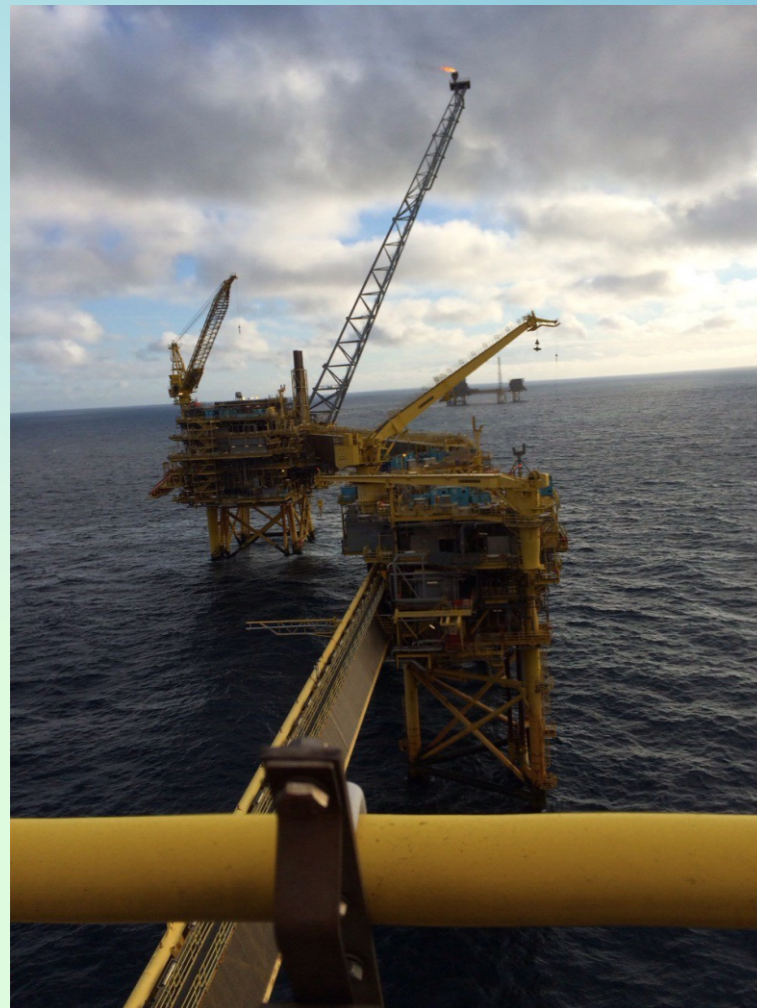

During this talk, you will find helpful information about what it is like to be an industry micropaleontologist and how to become one. To become a wellsite stratigrapher/micropaleontologist in the industry, start with a degree in geology/paleontology, ideally with hands-on experience through industry collaborations or internships and a successful interview. You'll need strong skills in fossil identification, geology, well-logging techniques, and the ability to work independently and as part of a team onshore and offshore, but don't be afraid you'll get some time and training. The work is fast-paced, requiring quick and accurate analysis to support real-time drilling decisions, but with dedication and resilience, hard work pays off. If you love to explore the world, don't be afraid and follow your dreams.
